	New item 8 <i>This is a new item to document the types of available membership</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) <i>Standard Membership – for current UQ Professional staff who are based at UQ Metropolitan Campuses (St Lucia and Brisbane)</i></li> <li>(b) <i>Regional Membership - for current UQ Professional staff where the location is such that it is both (i) outside of Metropolitan Brisbane and (ii) thus prevents professional staff attending UQPN Events in person. (This membership will be optional and not based on location)</i></li> <li>(c) <i>Friends (Friends of UQPN) - for past UQ Professional staff across all campuses who wish to remain in contact.</i></li> </ul>
